The service is in German and the main thoughts will be translated for you.

Families: older children are welcomed to the service. Parents with small children can listen to the message in the basement.

Offering: There are two boxes next to the exit of the hall. The offering goes to the Lord's work of 'Gemeinde für Christus' Switzerland (gfc.ch).

In the back of the church hall there is a small selection of **Bibles, Christian books and tracts** in English and other languages. Tracts are for free.

Toilets are outside the main entrance to the church.

EVANGELICAL FELLOWSHIP – PART OF THE GFC CHURCH

Since January 2021, the 'Evangelical Fellowship' is now integrated into the local GfC church. The services take place at the same location. At 10 am on the 2nd and 4th Sunday of each month someone with a fair command of English welcomes visitors and translates for them.

Should you be around on any other Sunday, please contact us and we will make sure that you are welcomed at the GfC church and someone will translate at least the main thoughts of the sermon for you. On the 1st and 3rd Sunday of the month the GfC church meets at 2pm.

MISSIONARY WORK IN GHANA

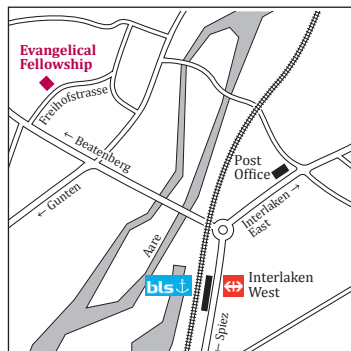

The new roundhouse is in good use for children's clubs, meetings and counselling and the water well is a bonus for the team and locals. The new building for the health project is still in construction. Let us support the whole team in our prayers: Toni and Marlies Lauber, Monika Trummer, Jael Leiser, Roland und Gunda Rösch, Pastor John and other locals and short termers. – The literature work in English and French for Ghana and the surrounding countries is being carried on from Accra by indigenous workers and supported by Toni and Marlies as they will be placed in Accra after their furlough in 2025.
