MISSIONARY NEWS AND PRAYER POINTS

Outreaches in Interlaken 2019: Particularly in summer, Interlaken is crowded with tourists from all over the world. The following activities are planned for the summer. As an answer to prayers we have received permission from the local authority for the dates we applied for. We value your prayers and invite you to participate in the outreaches.

- Literature outreaches: With the support of members from other churches we plan outreaches on the following dates: 7 June, 12 June, 19 June, 26 June, 6 July, 12 July, 26 July, 3 August, 7 August, 28 August, from 3.30 pm to 8 pm. There will be short times of prayer and information. Meeting point at the literature stand, at the 'Market Place', near 'Tea Room Rieder' or else we use an old post office bike to offer literature in different languages. - Open-air Services on Saturdays: 20 and 27 July, 10 and 17 August, at the market place opposite the post office, at 8 pm. Please pray for the planning (Bible messages, youth choir, alphorn playing, brass band, etc.).
- The OM team will be in Interlaken from 10 to 24 August. The team will be present at the open-air on Saturday, 17 August and some will join us for the Sunday Service on 18 August.

Urgent need for Bimbilla (Ghana): We still pray for new missionaries for Bimbilla, where literally "the harvest is plentiful, but the workers are few," therefore, let us "ask the Lord of the harvest, to send out workers into his harvest field" (Luke 10:2).

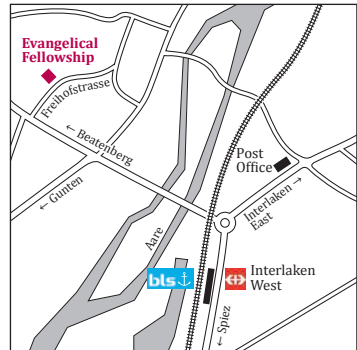
